NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE GAS (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1996

Pursuant to its powers under Article 14(1) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 (as amended) (the “**Order**”) the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (the “**Authority**”) hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) of the Order as follows:

1. The Authority proposes to modify the gas supply licence (the “**Licence**”) held by Flogas Enterprise Solutions Limited (the “**Licensee**”), a company established in a company incorporated in the Republic of Ireland (with registered number 376223) and having its principal place of business at 24-28 Tara Street, Dublin 2, D02 CX89.
2. The proposed modification is to amend the financial year in condition 1.2 of the Licence. The financial year (as set out in condition 1.2.1 of the Licence) currently runs from 01 January to the 31 December each year. The proposed modification will change the financial year to run from 01 April to 31 March.
3. The reason for the proposed modification is to bring the company’s accounting period into line with the financial year end of other companies within the DDC PLC group. The modification is being proposed following receipt by the Authority of a written request from the Licensee seeking the proposed modification to its Licence.
4. The Authority considers that the proposed modification will not have any effect on any other energy supplier, or on the Northern Ireland retail energy market more generally.
5. The proposed modification is set out below.

Condition 1.2.1 of the licence shall be substituted as follows:

“The first financial year of the Licensee shall run from the date this Condition comes into force to **31st December 2008** and thereafter each financial year of the Licensee shall run from **01 April** to the following **31 March**”.

6. The purpose of this notice is to bring the proposed modification to the attention of persons likely to be affected by it, and to invite representations or objections in connection thereto. In accordance with Article 14(3) of the Order, any representations or objections with respect to the proposed modification may be made on or before 29th April 2022 to:
