NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992

In pursuance of its powers under Article 14(1) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 (as amended) (the "**Order**") and having obtained the consent of the Licensee, the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (hereafter referred to as the "**Authority**") hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) of the Order as follows:

1 The Authority proposes to modify the electricity generation licences in the table below which were granted under Article 10(1)(a) of the Order.

- 2 The Authority proposes to modify each of the above licences by amending the financial year end, contained within Condition 2(1), of each licence to align with that recorded on the respective licensee's most recent financial statements.
- 3 Annex 1 to this notice outlines the proposed modification to each respective licence.
- 4 The reason for the proposed modification is to ensure consistency and accuracy by aligning the financial year in each licence to the respective licensee's own statutory financial year. The modification is being

proposed following interaction with each Licensee to confirm that the financial year end is now different to when the licence was granted.

- The effect of the proposed modification to each respective licence would be to align the financial year with the licensee's own statutory reporting period. The Authority considers that the proposed modification to each respective licence will not have any effect on any other electricity generation licensee.
- The purpose of this notice is to bring the proposed modification to the attention of persons likely to be affected by it, and to invite representations or objections in connection thereto. In line with Article 14(3) of the Order, any representations or objections with respect to the proposed modification may be made on or before 17.00 on 01 August 2022 to:
