



Notice under Article 14(2) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 – Modifications Proposed to the Gas Conveyance Licence held by Scotia Gas Networks Northern Ireland Ltd.

THE NORTHERN IRELAND AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY REGULATION NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE GAS (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1996 MODIFICATIONS PROPOSED TO THE GAS CONVEYANCE LICENCES HELD BY SCOTIA GAS NETWORKS NORTHERN IRELAND LTD.

The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation ('the Authority') proposes to modify the conditions of a licence in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 14(1) of the Gas (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 ("the Order").

In accordance with Article 14(2) of the Order the Authority gives notice as follows: -

- The Authority proposes to make modification to the gas conveyance licence ("the Licence") held by Scotia Gas Networks Northern Ireland Ltd. ("the Licensee").

- The effects of the proposed licence modifications are set out in chapters 2, 4, 5, and 6 of the attached consultation paper on Licence Modifications Pursuant to the GD23 Final Determination and other Regulatory Decisions.
