Accreditation Process



The following list sets out the accreditation process required to get us to Go-live and to full accreditation after Go-live.

- NIE Networks and LRQA agree the new scopes to be added to the NERS Northern Ireland Requirements Document
- LRQA updates and publishes the revised NERS Northern Ireland Requirements Document
- 3. Providers (ICPs) apply for a Partial Accreditation assessment
- LRQA assesses the ICP and verifies that the ICP's safety documentation deals with NIE Networks' concerns over potential inconsistencies between the NIE Networks' Safety Rules and the ICP's Safety Rules
- 5. ICP gains Partial Accreditation (valid for one year)
- 6. Go-Live
- 7. ICP to notify LRQA of the award of the first contract for a scope of work for which partial accreditation is held
- 8. Full accreditation process
