

Notice of grant of electricity supply licence for Erova Energy Limited

About the Utility Regulator

The Utility Regulator is the independent non-ministerial government department responsible for regulating Northern Ireland's electricity, gas, water and sewerage industries, to promote the short and long-term interests of consumers.

We are not a policy-making department of government, but we make sure that the energy and water utility industries in Northern Ireland are regulated and developed within ministerial policy as set out in our statutory duties.

We are governed by a Board of Directors and are accountable to the Northern Ireland Assembly through financial and annual reporting obligations.

We are based at Queens House in the centre of Belfast. The Chief Executive and two Executive Directors lead teams in each of the main functional areas in the organisation: CEO Office; Price Controls; Networks and Energy Futures; Markets; Consumer Protection and Enforcement. The staff team includes economists, engineers, accountants, utility specialists, legal advisors and administration professionals.



NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 10 OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992

The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (the **Authority**) hereby gives notice as follows:

- 1) The Authority, in accordance with Article 10(1)(c) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 (the **Order**), has granted a licence to supply electricity (the **Licence**) to Erova Energy Limited (the **Licensee**).
- 2) The premises to be supplied are set out in Schedule 1 of the Licence.
- 3) On 05 March 2025, the Authority published a notice¹, under Article 10(4) of the Order of its intention to grant a new electricity supply licence to Erova Energy Limited. The Authority asked for any representations or objections with respect to the proposal to grant an electricity supply licence to be made on or before on 04 April 2025.
- 4) We received no responses to the consultation.
- 5) Conditions 11(2) and 11(3) has been amended post consultation to align the fee payment dates with the new financial year. The financial year end date has been updated from 31 March 2025 to 31 March 2026 to reflect the current period. We consider this a minor correction with no significant impact.
- 6) The consolidated Licence is available on our website.
- 7) The Authority has sent a copy of this notice to the Licensee, the Department for the Economy and the Consumer Council for Northern Ireland.
