NOTICE UNDER ARTICLES 14(8)-(10) OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992

MODIFICATIONS TO THE ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION LICENCE HELD BY NORTHERN IRELAND ELECTRICITY NETWORKS LIMITED

In accordance with Article 14(2) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 ("the Order") the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation ("the Authority") published, on 15 January 2026, a notice ("the Consultation Notice") of its intention to modify Annex 2 of the electricity distribution licence ("the Licence") held by Northern Ireland Electricity Networks Limited ("the Licensee").

The modifications proposed were published with the Consultation Notice. In accordance with Article 14(5) of the Order, the Authority has considered representations duly made to it in response to that notice. The Authority has decided to proceed with the making of modifications of the conditions of the Licence in exercise of its powers under Article 14(1) of the Order.

In accordance with Article 14(8) of the Order the Authority gives notice as follows:

1. The conditions in Annex 2 of the Licence shall be modified in the manner set out in redline format in Annex B to the decision document published on the same date as this notice and entitled "Decision on Licence Modifications regarding the socialisation of reinforcement connection costs" (the **Decision Paper**).
2. The reasons why the Authority makes the licence modifications, and the effect of the modifications, are set out in Chapter 4 of the Decision Paper.
3. There are no changes between the modifications now being made and those set out in the Consultation Notice.
4. In accordance with Articles 14(9)-(10) of the Order, the licence modifications made in accordance with this notice shall have effect on and from 18 May 2026.
5. The Authority has, pursuant to Article 14(8)(a) of the Order, published this notice on its website. In addition, the Authority has sent a copy of this notice to the Licensee and provided a copy of it to the Department for Economy and the General Consumer Council for Northern Ireland.
