NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2) OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992

MODIFICATIONS TO THE PARTICIPATE IN TRANSMISSION LICENCE HELD BY NORTHERN IRELAND ELECTRICITY NETWORKS LIMITED

The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation ('the Authority') proposes to modify the conditions of a licence in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 14(1) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 ("the Order").

In accordance with Article 14(2) of the Order the Authority gives notice as follows:

- 1) The Authority proposes to make modifications to the Participate in Transmission Licence ("**the Licence**") held under Article 10(1)(b) of the Order by Northern Ireland Electricity Networks Limited ("**the Licensee**").
- 2) The proposed modifications are to the conditions of Annex 2 of the Licence, and are set out in separate tables in the relevant chapters of the attached consultation paper on "Proposed Modifications to NIE Networks Transmission and Distribution Licences – Additional allowances for network resilience, April 2026".
- 3) The details of the proposed modifications and of their effects are set out in chapters 2, 3, 5 and 6 of the attached consultation paper on "Proposed Modifications to NIE Networks Transmission and Distribution Licences – Additional allowances for network resilience".
- 4) The reasons why the Authority proposes to make the proposed licence modifications are set out in chapters 2, 3, 5 and 6 of the attached consultation paper on "Proposed Modifications to NIE Networks Transmission and Distribution Licences – Additional allowances for network resilience, April 2026".
