Re: Consultation on Seasonal Multiplier Factors for Gas Transmission

Dear Christopher,

GNI (UK) welcomes the opportunity to provide feedback on the Utility Regulator's (UR) 'Consultation on Seasonal Multiplier Factors for Gas Transmission'. (30th March 2026)


We note that this consultation relates to the proposed seasonal multiplier factors to be applied to non-annual entry capacity bookings in the postalised tariff from 1 October 2026, and the proposal to maintain the current factors into Gas Year 2026/2027.

We also affirm our understanding that this consultation paper meets requirements within the EU Regulation on establishing a network code on harmonised transmission tariff structures for gas, known as TAR NC.

Given that there is no change to the current factors, and that they remain aligned with the CRU/ROI multipliers, GNI (UK) agrees with the approach outlined in this consultation.
