Re: Network Code Modification Proposal 0024 – Inclusion of Forecasting Party arrangements, amendments to reflect introduction of, NI Gas Transmission Network Code and amendments to reflect changes to stages set out in NINEC Safety Case.

Thank you for submitting the modification report for code mod 0024 as required under Section 6 of the Code Modification Rules. We have reviewed the modification report and note that no responses were received during the consultation period.


The changes proposed include:

- Amendments to reflect the details of the Forecasting Party Agreement between DNO's and Premier Transmission
- Minor amendments to reflect introduction of NI Gas Transmission Network Code (e.g.) removal of references to Premier Transmission and Belfast Gas Transmission
- Incorporation of the modified four stage emergency process included in the NINEC Safety Case

The proposed change will ensure consistency and transparency for gas suppliers who utilize both the high and low pressure networks in Northern Ireland.

This Code Mod 0024 is approved, as of today's date. The modification is scheduled to be included in the Network Code from 30 September 2017.
