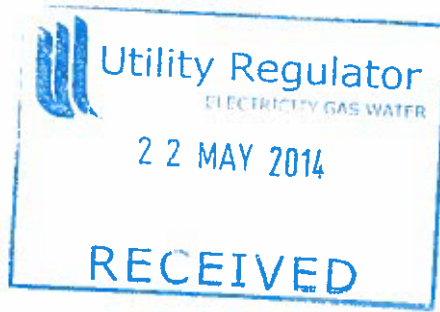

- (a) In relation to an applicant with a share capital, are to allotted shares; in relation to an applicant with capital but no share capital, are to rights to share in the capital of the applicant; and
- (b) In relation to an applicant without capital, are to interests:-
(i) conferring any rights to share in the profits or liability to contribute to the losses of the applicant; or
(ii) giving rise to an obligation to contribute to the debts or expenses of the applicant in the event of a winding up.

Note 3

"Related person" means:-

- (a) In relation to an applicant who is an undertaking within the meaning of section 1181 of the 2006 Act ("the principal undertaking"), a parent or subsidiary undertaking of the principal undertaking, or a subsidiary undertaking of a parent undertaking of the principal undertaking, in each case within the meaning given by section 1182 of the 2006 Act; and
- (b) In relation to any applicant (including such an undertaking) or connected person of the applicant with the meaning of Section 286 of the Taxation of Chargeable Gains Act 1992.
