Re: GNI(UK) Code Modification Proposal 21

Thank you for your recent submission of the Final Modification Report (FMR) in respect of the above named proposal. The purpose of the modification is to revise the congestion management procedures in the Northern Ireland regime to reflect the introduction of an entry-exit transmission model.

The Utility Regulation (UR) has considered the issues raised by this FMR.

GNI(UK) conclusion

GNI(UK) states in its FMR that the relevant objective (condition 2.4 of the GNI(UK) Licence), would be better facilitated by the Licensee's Network Code as a result of this modification.

Authority review and conclusions

We note no responses were received by GNI(UK) during the consultation period.

We have considered whether the proposal would better facilitate the 'relevant objective'.

Decision

As provided for in condition 2.4.7(c) of the GNI(UK) licence we direct GNI(UK) to implement the modifications as set out in the FMR dated 28th August 2015. The modifications should become effective as set out FMR No. 21.
