Re: Network Code Modification Proposal 002 – Introduction of EUC 1 daily demand profiles for both the domestic and the industrial & commercial tenures

Thank you for submitting the modification report for code mod 002 as required under Section 6 of the Code Modification Rules. We have reviewed the modification report and note that no responses were received during the consultation period.


The changes proposed include:

- The creation of a fourth end user category by splitting the existing EUC1 into two separate profiles, one for domestic tenure supply points and, one for industrial and commercial tenure.

The proposed changes do not meet the relevant objective. Implementation would require significant change to existing systems and processes, the costs of which would be borne by consumers. An analysis of the evidence provided in support of the proposal does not indicate that incurring these expenditures would be justified.

This Code Mod 002 is not approved, as of today's date. The modification will not be included in the Network Code.
