**Notice of Revocation of licence to supply electricity**

I can confirm receipt of the letter from Sanjay Verma (OVO Group Legal Director) dated 10 February 2020.

Please accept this letter as Notice of Revocation ("Notice") of the licence to supply electricity granted to ONI Electricity Limited on 21 December 2010 ("the Licence"). This Notice is given in accordance with section 1(a) of Schedule 2 to the Licence.

The revocation of the Licence shall take effect from 9 April 2020 ("the revocation date") being 30 days after the service of this Notice. Pursuant to Condition 1.7 of the Licence, the provisions of section 24 of the Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 ("the Act") apply for the purpose of the service of this Notice.

Under the Act, this Notice is deemed to have been served at the time at which the envelope (containing the Notice) has been delivered in the "ordinary course of post". We are taking the ordinary course of post to be three working days subsequent to the date of posting as a reasonable interpretation of the Act. This interpretation also aligns with the timings for the service of the notice of revocation of the licence to supply gas, granted to ONI Gas Limited.

As per Condition 11 of the Licence, a licence fee shall be payable for the year 2020/21, given that the Licence is still active until the revocation date given above. It is expected that this will be applied pro rata from 1 April 2020 until the date of revocation.
