Re: Utility Regulator Consultation on Aggregated Generating Unit (AGU) and Demand Side Unit (DSU) Licensing Arrangements.

Demand Response Aggregators of Ireland ("DRAI") is a recently formed association of nine Demand Side Unit (DSU) and Aggregated Generating Unit (AGU) providers in the SEM. Our purpose is to provide a single voice on policy and regulatory matters of common interest. We very much welcome the opportunity to respond to this consultation.

Our members are already familiar with the generic generation licence in Northern Ireland and support URegNI's proposed application of the slightly modified forms to AGU and DSU market participation.
