4. GD14 - FIRMUS ENERGY FINAL MAINS ALLOWANCE

- 4.1 Brian McHugh introduced this item which proposed mains allowances and which had previously been discussed by the board at its December meeting. He outlined the background to the paper and developments since the Board's previous discussion including further information provided by firmus in support of its position.
- 4.2 Several items were raised by the Board in discussion. These included: assumptions associated with the overall mains allowance on a meter per property passed, the domestic/non-domestic split for properties passed and the penetration profile for connections. More broadly, the Board considered the strategic question around future natural gas network development (and the specific query around the scope of possible connections)
- 4.3 At the conclusion of the discussion the Board approved a final mains allowance based on an average of up to 6.93m per property passed. The Board also discussed the most appropriate way of communicating this decision to firmus.
