MODIFICATIONS PROPOSED TO NIE ENERGY LTD'S ELECTRICITY SUPPLY LICENCE

The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (hereafter referred to as "the **Authority**") hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) of the Order as follows:

- The effect of the proposed modifications will be to remove the Licensee as the Error Supplier Unit due to the move to Global Settlement.
- The reasons for the proposed modifications are set out in the document entitled "Consultation on Global Settlements in the SEM for Northern Ireland". The document accompanies this modification notice on the Authority's website.
