RE: NI Network Gas Transmission Code Modification No 4

Thank you for your recent submission of the Final Modification Report (FMR) in respect of the above named proposal. The purpose of the modification is "housekeeping" including changing the name of the CJV Agreement to the SSO Agreement, using the correct defined terms in the Demand Forecasting Section, removal of redundant terms, addition of missing defined terms in the Appendix and various minor typographical corrections.

Authority review and conclusions

The Utility Regulator has considered the issues raised by this FMR. We note that there was one response received during the consultation period which was supportive. We are content that the proposal would better facilitate the 'relevant objective' as the changes will support the economic and efficient operation of the network by ensuring that the Code is as accurate and up to date as possible.

Decision

As provided for in condition 2.4D.9(c) of the relevant licences we direct the Transporter to implement the modifications as set out in FMR No 4 dated 7th November 2018. The modifications should become effective as set out in the FMR.
