## The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation Notice under Article 42 (1) of the Energy (Northern Ireland) Order 2003

Proposed Final Order in relation to a finding of a breach of a relevant requirement by Project Plug Ltd trading as Click Energy ("the Licensee")

The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation ("the Authority") proposes to make a Final Order in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 42(1) of the Energy (Northern Ireland) Order 2003 ("the Order")

In accordance with Article 43(1) of the Order the Authority gives notice as follows:

- The Authority proposes to make a final order in relation to the licensee following a determination of the Enforcement Committee dated 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2018.
- 2. The Authority is satisfied that the licensee breached, and continues to be in breach of a relevant requirement under the Renewables Obligation Order (Northern Ireland) 2009 ("the Renewables Order".) A relevant requirement covers statutory requirements as listed in Article 41A of the Order. The Renewables Order is included as a relevant requirement under this list. Failure to comply with the Renewables Order is subject to the Authority's duty to enforce under Article 42 of the Order.
- 3. The licensee did not submit the required number of Renewable Obligation

  Certificates to the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets ("Ofgem") nor did it make
  payment of the equivalent late payment fee of 31st October 2017.
- 4. The licensee failed to make the full payment on two further dates, as proposed by the licensee.
- 5. This matter was referred to an Enforcement Committee of the Authority who found that they are in breach of a relevant requirement.
- 6. The effect of this proposed final order will be to ensure that the licensee complies with their statutory obligation under the Renewables Order and makes payment to Ofgem of £162,473.14 by 29<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

7. The Authority considers it appropriate in the circumstances of this case to propose a final order.
