

**NOTICE UNDER ARTICLE 14(2)
OF THE ELECTRICITY (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1992**

**MODIFICATION OF
SSE RENEWABLES UK LTD GENERATION LICENCE**

In pursuance of its powers under Article 14(1) of the Electricity (Northern Ireland) Order 1992 (as amended) (the “**Order**”), the Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (the “**Authority**”) hereby gives notice under Article 14(2) as follows:

- 1 We propose to modify the generation licence (the “**Licence**”) held by SSE Renewables UK Ltd (the “**Licensee**”).
- 2 The proposed modification is to amend Schedule 2 Authorised Generating Sites of the Licence.
- 3 The Licensee is currently constructing a wind farm at Tievenameenta and requires their Licence to be modified to take account of this expansion.
- 4 The effect of the proposal is to replace the entirety of Schedule 2 of the Licence to reflect the new site lands of the wind farm at Tievenameenta.
- 5 A copy of the proposed modifications is set out in Annex 1.

Modifications to SSE Renewables UK Ltd's Generation Licence

It is proposed to replace the entirety of Schedule 2 of SSE Renewables UK Ltd's generation licence with the following:

Schedule 2: Authorised Generating Sites

1. Slieve Kirk Windfarm

Lisdillon Road
County Londonderry
Northern Ireland.
Site lands;

(a) bounded by Bigwood Road, Kildoag Road and Castlewarren Road within the townlands of Lisdillon, Kildoag in County Londonderry, Knockbrack, Gosheden, Lackagh, Ardground, Legagh in County Tyrone.

(b) at Glenconway Hill off Baranailt Road (adjacent to Loughermore Forest and north of Altahullion Windfarm) Limavady and townlands of Drum, Glenconway and Ballymoney, near Dungiven, County Londonderry.

2. Tievenameenta Windfarm

Pullytean Rd,
Killeter,
County Tyrone
Northern Ireland

Site lands;

a) Tievenameenta Windfarm is situated in the townlands of Creigshane, Ballymongan, Shanaghy, Tievenameenta and Crighdenis, Co Tyrone. It is located at the end of the Pullytean Rd and is bounded by the Shanaghy Road.
