Final Order in relation to a finding of a breach of a relevant requirement by Project Plug Ltd trading as Click Energy (“the Licensee”)

The Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (“the Authority”) hereby makes a Final Order in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 42 of the Energy (Northern Ireland) Order 2003 (“the Order”)

In accordance with the Order the Authority hereby makes Final Order against the licensee.


The Authority is satisfied that the licensee breached a relevant requirement under the Renewables Obligation Order (Northern Ireland) 2009 (“the Renewables Order”). The licensee did not submit the required number of Renewables Obligation Certificates to the Office of Gas and Electricity Markets (“Ofgem”) nor did it make payment of the equivalent late payment fee of 31st October 2017.

The Authority received no objections or representations in relation to the proposed final order. The Authority hereby confirms that a final order is made against the licensee.

The licensee is hereby required by the terms of this Order to comply with their statutory duty under the Renewables Order and to make payment of £162,473.14 to Ofgem by 29th June 2018.

The Authority has, pursuant to Article 43(5)(a) of the Order, sent a copy of this notice to the Licensee.
